You are hereby notified that pursuant to Article IX, § 7 of the International Union Constitution, a hearing will be held before a Special Hearings Panel of the General Executive Board on March 15, 2017, at the Courtyard New York LaGuardia Airport by Marriott, 9010 Ditmars Blvd., East Elmhurst, New York 11369, commencing at 8:00 a.m. to consider whether a Supervision should be imposed over Local Union 29, Astoria, New York.

Article II, §3(g) of the Uniform Local Union Constitution provides that the General President may suspend the charter of a Local Union having less than 300 members if the Local Union is no longer effectuating the purposes for which it was chartered. Local Union 29's membership is currently above 300. However, within the past two years it has been below that number and, given the cyclical nature of the Local Union's work, may be so again. The question is how to best serve the long-term interests of Local Union 29's membership in light of the boom or bust nature of its work as a specialty Local Union. Further, Business Manager Thomas Russo has indicated that he intends to retire in the relatively near future. Thought must be given to the impact of this decision upon the Local Union's long range prospects. A Supervision is proposed to allow for a comprehensive review and consideration of these issues.
